

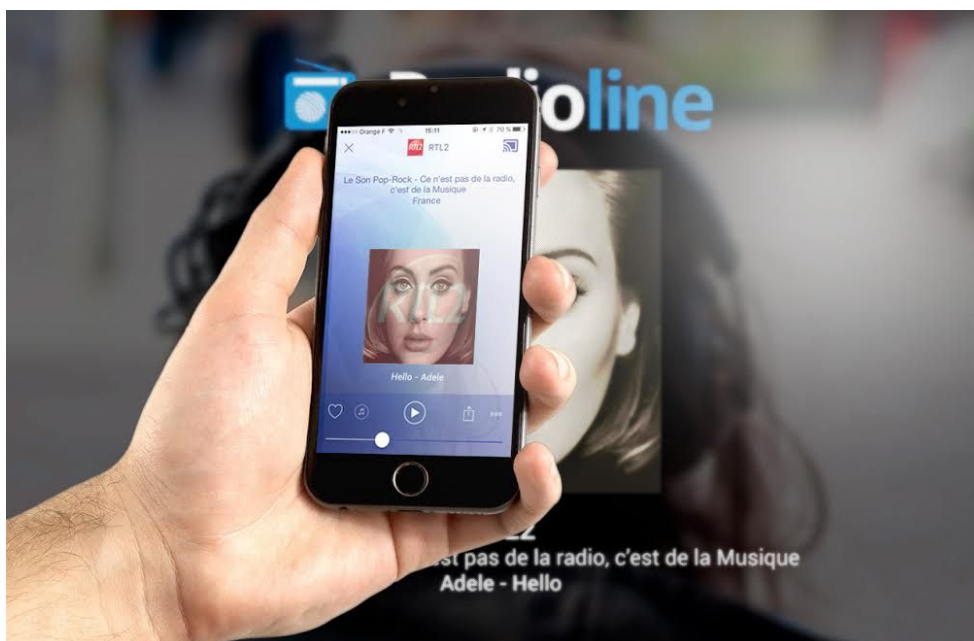
Radioline is now Chromecast compliant

Paris, October 3rd 2016 - Radioline, the leading European radio and podcasts aggregator, has just released a new update of its mobile applications, integrating the compatibility with the Google Cast technology (including Chromecast).

After signatures with TV partners such as Canal+ or VOO, Radioline continues its deployment “at home”, making its mobile application (iOS and Android) compliant with the Google Cast technology (Google Cast Audio, Chromecast, and Android TV). Radioline now allows its users to listen to their favorite radio stations and podcasts on their TV or on their audios speakers. The Google Cast technology also allows to display the metadata and radio programs on TV.

When a Chromecast device is detected by Radioline, a Cast icon appears, allowing the users to start streaming instantly.
